Dear Parents, Staff and Students,

Next week we commence Holy Week and at the heart of our faith story are the events of Christ's ministry – His life, death, and resurrection. During this week we are led to contemplate once again that Jesus was both a person and at the same time, divine. As a community of faith we walk with Christ and one another through the triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday to the bitter agony on the cross and to the empty tomb and the joyful resurrection of Easter Sunday. We walk not in great strides during this week but in small steps, passing through each movement mindful that we will reach the Resurrection and that, just like our own life, we will be forever transformed by the journey.

The events of Holy Week remind us of our calling to be active Christians in the way that we lead our own lives. If we are harbouring hurt within us, Jesus' actions can encourage us towards forgiveness and away from grudges and bitterness. We have all experienced hurt through the actions or words of another. If we have carried this hurt for years then we have deprived ourselves of the opportunity to embrace peace, hope, gratitude and joy.

Forgiveness is a decision to let go of resentment and thoughts of revenge so we can move away from our role as victim and relieve the power, that the offending person or situation has on our life. As we let go of hurt and resentment, we open ourselves to find compassion and understanding. Slowly, we embrace forgiveness and begin once more to live a truly Christian life.

Jesus' example to us on Good Friday, clearly defined for us the extent of God's forgiveness and the encouragement for us to do likewise in our own limited human way. But Jesus' example has an after effect as well, for on Easter Sunday He rose gloriously to a new life.

Jesus brought us the promise of new life, and that is why we celebrate with Easter eggs and chickens, as newly hatched chicks are a sign of new life.

I would like to invite all parents to attend our liturgy tomorrow Thursday 11 April commencing at 11:30am.

For your convenience, parents attending the Liturgy are requested to access the playground <u>via the gate near the hall which will be open from 11:20am</u>. There is no need to sign in at the office. The liturgy duration will be approximately 40 minutes.

Our gratitude to the students for their sense of the sacred and to the teachers for their outstanding dedication in this area.

From all those who work and learn at St Monica's we wish everyone a holy, safe and blessed Easter.

Notice of Intention to Remove a Student from St Monica's School

The Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta Office has developed a Policy relating to the notice required from parents to terminate their children's enrolment in the schools of the Parramatta Diocese. In part this states:

"A term's notice (10 weeks) in writing must be given to the principal before the removal of a student or a full term's fees will be paid. The notice can be given any time during the term for the next term."

This means that unless the school receives a term's notice no pro rata adjustment will be given for part term tuition.


