Preparing for 2020

Please remember the following as you prepare for the new school year:

All students are expected to wear the St Monica's uniform with pride throughout the year. This includes wearing the correct hat, socks and shoes. This helps to keep students focused on their learning whilst also maintaining a consistent atmosphere across the school.

- School shoes are black leather lace ups/Velcro/buckle.
- Sport shoes are <u>predominately white</u> for sport with white laces.
- No slip on "Raben" type shoes or coloured joggers, runners or basketball boots are to be worn.

I know that once Term 4 commences that some children genuinely grow out of their shoes and parents are reluctant to buy new shoes for the remaining weeks of the year.
